Suzion wins 50.4MW wind project

Pune: Wind turbine maker, Suzlon, said on Thursday that it has secured a winning order for the development of a 50.4 mega-watt (MW) wind project from Atria Power. The company did not disclose the size of the winning order.

According to industry estimates, this could fetch the company around Rs300 crore over the course of the order. "The project is located in Tuticorin, Tamil Nadu and is in the advanced stages. It will be commissioned in two phases by the first half of fiscal 2020," said the company in a statement.

It said that it will install 12 units of S111-140m and 12 units of S120-140m wind turbine generators (WTGs) with a hybrid lattice tubular (HLT) tower, with a rated capacity of 2.1MW each.
