

Gujarat to get 30,000 MW renewable energy park

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday will lay the foundation stone for what is billed as the world's largest hybrid renewable energy park in Gujarat's Kutch district.

The park will generate 30,000 MW power through solar panels and windmills on 72,600 hectares along the India-Pakistan border. It is being set up by the Gujarat government with the participation of private players such as the Adani Group, which is the country's largest renewable power generator, and Suzlon, a dominant player in wind energy.
